Woodmeister Master Builders Completes Move for Expansion

(Holden, Mass.) Woodmeister Master Builders, an award-winning Massachusetts company known nationwide for its luxury residential construction work, custom cabinetry and interiors, and lifestyle management services, has relocated to Holden. The \$27 million firm completed its move to One Woodmeister Way (formerly 120 Industrial Drive) in the Holden Industrial Park earlier this month. The company has a five-year lease, with an option to buy, on the 105,400 square foot building owned by Astro Realty.

The relocation consolidates Woodmeister's operations and 155 employees under one roof and creates expansion space for the rapidly growing business. Headquartered in central Massachusetts for the past twenty-six years, the company previously occupied 40,000 square feet in three different Worcester locations. Woodmeister also has sales offices in Newton, Nantucket, and Newport, Rhode Island, which will not be affected by the move.

Goodnow founded Woodmeister Master Builders in 1980 as a custom cabinetry and millwork shop. Since then the firm has evolved into a nationally renowned leader in the affluent residential market. Sales for 2006 are projected to be \$27 million.
